

# Update on Student Accommodation Payments for 2025 Academic Year.

Following approval of additional funds, NSFAS will implement the following process to ensure that all categories of affected students are addressed appropriately:

- For university students who applied during the TVET cycle - NSFAS will pay the full cost for all valid registrations received, covering a period of 10 months. It is important to emphasize that not all students in this category will receive payment. NSFAS previously communicated a list to institutions indicating that claims for students appearing on this list will not be paid, as these students had applied late and were registered after the official notification date.
- For students whose funding was confirmed after the registration upload portal had closed, NSFAS will also pay the full cost for all valid registrations received, covering 10 months.
- For students with approved appeals, NSFAS will make payments based on valid registration data received.
- For the 2025 second semester, NSFAS will open a portal for institutions to upload the registration data of these students. Full payment for all valid registrations submitted through this channel will be made.

# Update on the 2024 Outstanding Payments



- NSFAS requested that solution partners resubmit all invoices for both TVET Colleges and universities. This measure was implemented to ensure that all invoices undergo thorough validation and verification in line with the enhanced processes introduced because of the discrepancies identified earlier.
- All the invoices have been received and have gone through the comprehensive review and validations.
- The process has been finalised and NSFAS will issue communique with timelines of payment.

# NSFAS Student Accommodation Protocol



National Student Financial Aid Scheme

- NSFAS has developed a student accommodation protocol which outlines its commitment to ensuring that eligible students have access to safe, affordable, and academically conducive accommodation during their period of study. It is developed in recognition of the critical role that appropriate living environments play in student well-being, academic success, and retention within the higher education system.
- This protocol aims to standardise the provision of accommodation support, promote quality and safety, and foster accountability among all stakeholders.
- The protocol does not aim to regulate all student accommodation in South Africa, but its intention is to ensure that NSFAS funded students reside in conducive environments.
- NSFAS has shared the protocol with USAF, SAPCO, SAUDS, SATVETSA and private accommodation associations for their written input with a deadline of 21 September 2025.
- NSFAS will consolidate the input and, thereafter, share a consolidated document.
